# Recipe Box

## Chicken Spagetti

### **Ingredients:**

1 whole raw chicken, cut into 8 pieces  
1 pound thin spaghetti, broken into 2-inch pieces  
2 1/2 cups shredded sharp Cheddar  
1/4 cup finely diced green bell pepper  
1/4 cup finely diced red bell pepper  
1 teaspoon seasoned salt  
1/8 to 1/4 teaspoon cayenne pepper  
Two 10 3/4-ounce cans cream of mushroom soup  
1 medium onion, finely diced  
Salt and freshly ground black pepper

### **Directions:**

Preheat the oven to 350 degrees F.  
Bring a large pot of water to a boil.  
Add the chicken pieces to the boiling water and boil for a few minutes, then return the heat to medium-low and simmer, 30 to 45 minutes. Remove the chicken and 2 cups of the chicken cooking broth from the pot.  
When the chicken is cool, remove the skin and pick out the meat (a mix of dark and white) to make 2 generous cups.  
Cook the spaghetti in the same chicken cooking broth until al dente. Do not overcook.  
When the spaghetti is cooked, combine with the chicken, mushroom soup, 1 1/2 cups cheese, the green peppers, red peppers, onions, seasoned salt, cayenne, and sprinkle with salt and pepper.  
Stir in 1 cup of the reserved chicken cooking broth, adding an additional cup if needed.  
Place the mixture in a casserole pan and top with the remaining 1 cup cheese.  
Cover and freeze up to 6 months, cover and refrigerate up to 2 days or bake immediately until bubbly, about 45 minutes. (If the cheese on top starts to get too cooked, cover with foil).

**September 2019**

**1<sup>st</sup>** Excellent for sowing grains, hay, and forage crops. Plant flowers. Good day for planting peas, beans, tomatoes, peppers, and other aboveground crops in southern Florida, Texas, and California.

**2<sup>nd</sup> - 3<sup>rd</sup>** Start seedbeds. Excellent time for planting aboveground crops that can be planted now, including leafy vegetables which will do well.

**4<sup>th</sup> - 6<sup>th</sup>** Clear fencerows, wood lots, and fields, but do no planting.

**7<sup>th</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup>** Any aboveground crops that can be planted now will do well.

**9<sup>th</sup> - 11<sup>th</sup>** Poor planting days. Kill plant pests.

**12<sup>th</sup> - 13<sup>th</sup>** Extra good for vine crops. Favorable days for planting aboveground crops.

**14<sup>th</sup> - 16<sup>th</sup>** A poor time to plant.

**17<sup>th</sup> - 18<sup>th</sup>** Good days for transplanting. Good days for planting root crops.

**19<sup>th</sup> - 21<sup>st</sup>** Seeds planted now tend to rot in ground.

**22<sup>nd</sup> - 23<sup>rd</sup>** Plant seedbeds and flower gardens. Good days for transplanting. Fine planting days for fall potatoes, turnips, onions, carrots, beets, and other root crops.

**1<sup>st</sup> - 3<sup>rd</sup>** Showers, thunderstorms, some heavy.

**4<sup>th</sup> - 7<sup>th</sup>** Showers briefly subside; warm, humid.

**8<sup>th</sup> - 11<sup>th</sup>** Showery for lee slopes of Rockies, as well as the southern Plains.

**12<sup>th</sup> - 15<sup>th</sup>** Showers, thunderstorms for Texas, Oklahoma, Arkansas, northern Louisiana, and then cooler weather. Clear, colder weather for New Mexico.

**16<sup>th</sup> - 19<sup>th</sup>** Clear to partly cloudy skies, warm for Louisiana. Crisp, chilly over southern Rockies, southern Plains. Eastward-moving showers for Arkansas.
